Dear Parents and Carers,

At the last P&C Meeting, the Executive presented a proposal to contract the operations and management of the P&C Uniform Shop. There was considerable interest in the proposal but unfortunately, there was not time at the meeting to elaborate on much of the detail.

The Executive has decided to allocate the 2nd September date to a special Public Meeting to address safety on Reiby Rd directly with Hunters Hill Councillors and local residents, which will allow the P&C to then address Council's next General Meeting on 9th September. Consequently, we have decided to call a Special Meeting solely to address the Uniform Shop proposal on 29th August, 7:00pm in the School Common Room. There will be minimal other business dealt with at that meeting.

Please note that, as per our rules, only current 2019 P&C financial members are permitted to vote at the upcoming meeting. It is not possible to become a financial member and vote at that meeting itself.

The Executive appreciates that many members are eager to understand the details of the proposal. The options, due diligence undertaken by the Executive, and expected improvements for the school body will be presented. The Executive would like to address this item as soon as reasonably possible in order to focus on Reiby Rd and other core P&C matters, and to move forwards as a P&C to ensure we can welcome the new Year 7 students and their parents to a clear agenda in 2020.

The Agenda for the special meeting to be held on 29 August 2019 is attached for your convenience as well as important information regarding the Public Meeting to be held on 2 September 2019 to address pedestrian safety on Reiby Rd.
