

2015 YEAR 10 YEARLY EXAMINATIONS

Term 4 Weeks 6 & 7 From Thursday 12th November to Wednesday 18th November

Instructions to Students:

On all examination papers, students record their names.

- 1. Full school uniform is to be worn to all exams.
- 2. Exam conditions are to be followed. Failure to follow procedures may incur a "zero" penalty.
- 3. Do not take any materials into the exam room except your pens in your hand and a calculator where allowed. Borrowing of equipment during the exam will not be allowed.
- 4. MOBILE PHONES must be turned off and in your bags. Failure to follow procedures may incur a "zero" penalty.
- 5. All students are expected to stay for the *entire duration* of each exam.
- 6. Be present for your exams on time.
- 7. Check your timetable carefully. No extra time will be given if you miss an examination session through misreading the timetable.
- 8. The exams will be held in the school hall, with the exception of a few exams. Your class teacher will inform you of any alternate locations.
- 9. Remain outside the hall until a teacher instructs you to go in.
- 10. Writing paper for all exams will be supplied.
- 11. Attendance at school is required for the entire school day.

IMPORTANT: Missed exams

- If you know you will be absent for an exam you must see your class teacher/ Head Teacher prior to the exam to determine an alternative exam time
- If you are sick **immediately before** an exam:
 - 1. There is an expectation that absence due to ill health will be backed by a medical certificate
 - 2. Contact the school to advise reception that you will be absent. Ph 9817 4565
 - 3. Present your medical certificate and illness/misadventure form to Deputy Principal Mr Murphy, as soon as possible after missed exam.
 - 4. You will be advised if your application is successful and when an alternative exam will be.
