If you do not follow these examination instructions you may not be awarded marks for that examination.

1. Most examinations will be held in the school hall.
2. Full school uniform must be worn to all examinations.
3. All students are expected to stay for the entire examination.
4. No consideration will be given if you are late or miss an examination. **Check your timetable carefully.**
5. Arrive at least 10 minutes before your examination starts and wait outside the hall until a teacher instructs you to enter.
6. Only a clear water bottle, pens in a clear container and an approved calculator (if permitted) to your desk.
7. Electronic language translation devices can't be used in formal examinations.
8. Do not take any device with wireless or bluetooth connectivity (mobile phone, tablets, connective watches) to your desk. All electronic devices and mobile phones must be turned off and secured in bags.
9. The school strongly recommends that students do not bring valuable items to examinations and the school takes no responsibility for valuables.
10. Record your name on all examination papers.
11. You will not be allowed to borrow equipment during the examination.
12. Writing paper will be supplied for all examinations.
13. Students only need to be at school during their timetabled examinations.
14. Students are required to attend TAFE as normal during the examination period.
