- 1. If you do not follow the examination procedures you may not be awarded any marks for that subject.
- 2. Most examinations will be held in the school hall.
- 3. Full school uniform must be worn to all examinations.
- 4. All students are expected to stay for the entire examination.
- 5. No extra time will be given if you are late or miss an examination. Check your timetable carefully.
- 6. Arrive at least 10 minutes before your examination starts and wait outside the hall until a teacher instructs you to enter.
- 7. Only take a clear water bottle, pens in a clear container and a calculator (if required) to your desk.
- 8. Electronic language translation devices can not be used in formal examinations.
- 9. Do not take any device with wireless or bluetooth connectivity (mobile phone, tablets, connective watches) to your desk.
- 10. All electronic devices and mobile phones must be turned off and secured in bags.
- 11. The school strongly recommends that students do not bring valuable items to examinations and the school takes no responsibility for any valuables.
- 12. Record your name on all examination papers.
- 13. You will not be allowed to borrow equipment during the examination.
- 14. Writing paper will be supplied for all examinations.
- 15. Students only need to be at school during their timetabled examinations.
- 16. Students are required to attend TAFE as normal during the examination period.

### If you miss an examination because you are sick.

- 1. You must obtain a Doctor's Certificate on and for that day.

- 3. You must provide a medical certificate and fill in an *Application for Consideration of Illness/Misadventure*. These applications must be on the correct form and must be signed by your parent/guardian.
- 4. *Applications for Consideration of Illness/Misadventure* must be submitted to the Head Teacher of the subject as soon as possible after missed examination.
- 5. You will be advised if your application is successful and when an alternative examination will be scheduled.
