

# 2017 YEAR 11 HALF YEARLY EXAMINATIONS Term 1 Weeks 10 & 11 From Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> March to Friday7th April

#### **Instructions to Students:**

#### On all examination papers, students record their names.

- 1. Full school uniform is to be worn to all exams.
- 2. All students are expected to stay for the *entire duration* of each exam.
- 3. No extra time will be given if you miss an examination session through misreading the timetable.
- 4. Be present for your exams at least 10 minutes prior to their commencement.
- 5. The exams will be held in the school hall. Check your timetable carefully.
- 6. Remain outside the hall until a teacher instructs you to go in.
- 7. Do not take any materials into the exam room except your pens in your hand and a calculator where allowed. Borrowing of equipment during the exam will not be allowed. MOBILE PHONES must be turned off and in your bags. Failure to follow procedures may incur a "zero" penalty.
- 8. Writing paper for all exams will be supplied.
- 9. Attendance at school is required for timetabled exams only. TAFE should be attended as normal.

#### **IMPORTANT: Missed exams**

## If you are sick **immediately before** an exam:

- 1. You must obtain a Doctor's Certificate for that day.
- 2. Contact the school to advise reception that you will be absent. Ph 9817 4565
- 3. Present your medical certificate and illness/misadventure form to Head Teacher of the faculty, as soon as possible after missed exam.
- 4. You will be advised if your application is successful and when an alternative exam will be held.
